St. Bernadette's Catholic Parish



St. Bernadette's Parish was founded in

1947 in Lakewood, Colorado, and is dedicated to Bernadette of Soubirous.

We first opened a parish school in 1953.



Today, our parish school, Wellspring Catholic Academy, serves many families of limited means. **85% of families** attending our preschool receive free or reduced-price meals.



In 2023, families received

over \$250,000 in scholarships.

St. Mary's Catholic Parish



St. Mary's Parish was **founded in 1951** in Littleton, Colorado and is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We have operated a preschool program as a ministry of the Parish since **2006**.



25% of students who attend St. Mary's preschool receive tuition discounts or scholarships.



We are an **inclusive preschool**, meaning that we provide services to students with disabilities, including students with Down syndrome and autism.
