ORDER

On August 3, 2021, this Court entered a Temporary Restraining Order enjoining Defendants, their agents, officers, and employees, and all other persons and entities in active concert or participation with them, from enforcing Executive Order No. GA-37. ECF No. 18. As set out at the hearing held on this day, the Court has extended the restraining order for a period of fourteen days.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Temporary Restraining Order, ECF No. 18, **SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT** for an additional fourteen (14) days until the 27th day of August, 2021.
